STUDENT PROFILE FIU currently enrolls more than 37,000 students, 1,100 full-time faculty, and 100,000 alumni, making it the largest university in South Florida and placing it among the nation's 25 largest colleges and universities. Over half of the students are minorities: 52% Hispanic, 19.5% African descent, and 4% Asian. According to *Black Issues in Higher Education* (July 2003), FIU ranked as the nation's number one producer of Hispanic-American graduates with baccalaureate and masters degrees. Since Fall of 1972, more than 100,000 students have graduated from the university.
