Please clear in the SASS the above student for the Arts and Sciences foreign language requirement; the student has fulfilled the requirement as listed below.

1. Student has completed a two-semester sequence in one language in a post-secondary institution with a C or better even if the credit earned is fewer than 8 credits.
2. Student was admitted to the University for Summer 1998 or before.
3. Student passed the CLEP (College Level Examination Program) Subject Exam with at least the following scores: Spanish--55, French--56, or German--55. (CLEP exams are given at Miami-Dade Community College.)
4. Student passed the SAT II Subject Exam with at least the following scores: Spanish--690, French--690, or German--690. (Student who wishes to take the SAT II may consult with the Testing Office for the next test date.)
5. Student was awarded 2 course equivalencies in 1 language, based on Advanced Placement language scores (AP classes are taken in high school). Score of 4 or higher required.
6. Student has successfully completed with a grade of C or better (C- does not count): a) the second semester of a two-semester sequence basic language course or b) any second-year or third-year foreign language course, even if the credit earned is fewer than eight credits.
7. Student earned an A.A. degree by the end of the summer semester 1998 at a Florida public community college or university.
8. Student enrolled before or during the summer semester 1998 in a degree program at a Florida public college or university and has maintained continuous enrollment up to the present (i.e., at least one course per academic year) in that institution and then here.
9. Student had to submit a passing TOEFL (Test of English as a Foreign Language) score for admission to the university.
10. Student presented secondary or post-secondary foreign credentials indicating that instruction in those institutions was received in a language other than English.
11. Student possesses a bachelor's degree and is returning to college for a second bachelor's degree.
