Some additional restrictions on course substitutions and transfers:

- Of the graduate elective courses, at least two courses must be within the Environmental Studies Department.
- A maximum of six credits of post-baccalaureate graduate course work may be transferred from other institutions.
- A maximum of six credit hours may be taken at 4000 level.
- A maximum of five credit hours of Independent Study (EVR 5907) may be applied toward graduation.
- Graduate-level statistics elective of 6 credits may be replaced with non-statistics electives if you already have statistics background from your undergraduate program (with a minimum of "B" grade in all 6 credits). This substitution needs to be approved by your major advisor and the Graduate Program Director.
