

## ADOPTION AGREEMENT

I/We, \_\_\_\_\_, the undersigned Adopter (hereinafter referred to as Adopter), agree to all of the conditions set forth within these pages of this adoption agreement as set forth below by \_\_\_\_\_ (Rescuer) in order to adopt \_\_\_\_\_ (Animal's name) for a donation of \$ \_\_\_\_\_.

This agreement will be in effect as of \_\_\_\_\_ (Date) and will continue until the death of aforementioned animal. Death of the animal, repossession of the animal by the Rescuer, or return of the animal to the Rescuer (for any reason), shall be sufficient to terminate this Agreement.

### CONDITIONS OF ADOPTION AGREEMENT

The animal will be returned to Rescuer if, under any circumstances, the Adopter is no longer able to keep the animal. The animal will wear a semi-slip, non-slip, or buckle collar at all times (not a slip, choke, or pinch collar except during supervised training or other supervised activities) with a current Rabies license and ID tag showing the name and phone number of the Adopter at all times.

The aforementioned animal will live in the Adopter's home as a member of the family. If the animal is housed outdoors at any time, it will be in a minimum 5' - 6' tall enclosure (whatever we deemed necessary to keep the animal enclosed), no less than 200 square feet. The enclosure will provide the animal with shelter from the sun and bad weather and will provide shade. There will be fresh water provided at all times, and food will be provided daily (preferably a high quality kibble).

The animal will not be used for dog fighting, medical experimentation, and will not be subjected to abuse, cruelty, or neglect by the Adopter. To do so will null and void this agreement and will result in our confiscation of the animal.

If the animal is lost or stolen, the Adopter will immediately notify the Rescuer by telephone. The Adopter agrees to make every effort to locate the Animal, including placing ads in local newspapers and regularly checking the local animal shelters. If the Adopter moves from the address listed above, he must notify the Rescuer in writing.

### MEDICAL CONDITIONS OF ADOPTION AGREEMENT

The animal will be given annual vaccinations to include parvo, distemper, parainfluenza, leptovirus, hepatitis, corona virus, and Rabies. The Animal will be given annual heartworm checks and monthly heartworm preventative will be administered the entire year.

Furthermore, if said animal is intact, the Adopter is responsible for spaying/neutering the Animal within two weeks of receiving the Animal. If the Animal is younger than five months of age, then the Adopter agrees to spay/neuter said Animal by the time the Animal is six months old.

The Animal will be taken to a licensed veterinarian if sick (not to an Animal Shelter or Humane Society). If returned to the Rescuer in poor health, as determined by the Rescuer and a licensed Veterinarian, then the Adopter will be responsible for any and all medical treatment necessary.

The undersigned Adopter agrees to accept all responsibility for the behavior and health of the Animal chosen for adoption, and agrees to ALL CONDITIONS on these pages. This contract is binding under the laws of the State of Florida.
