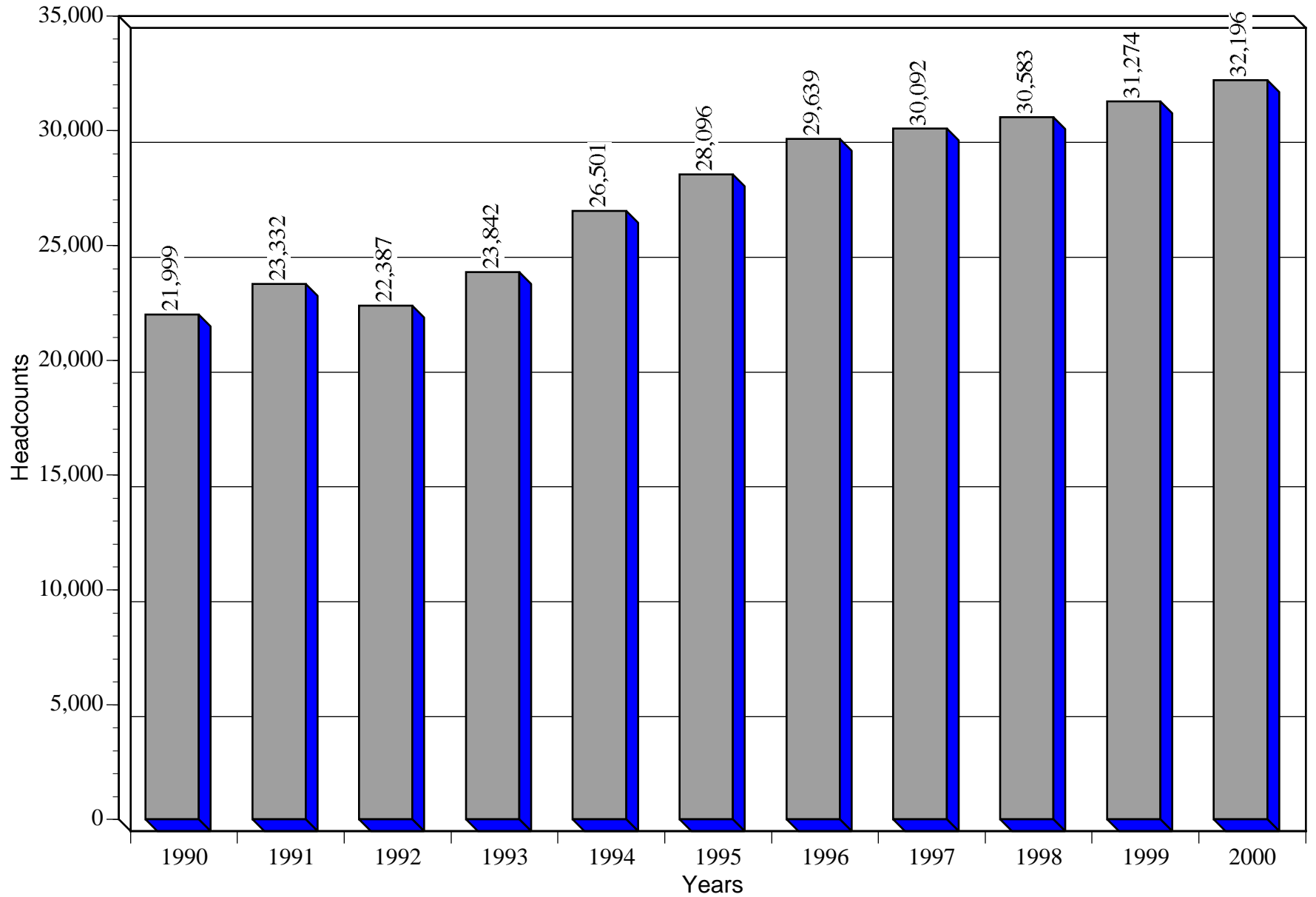

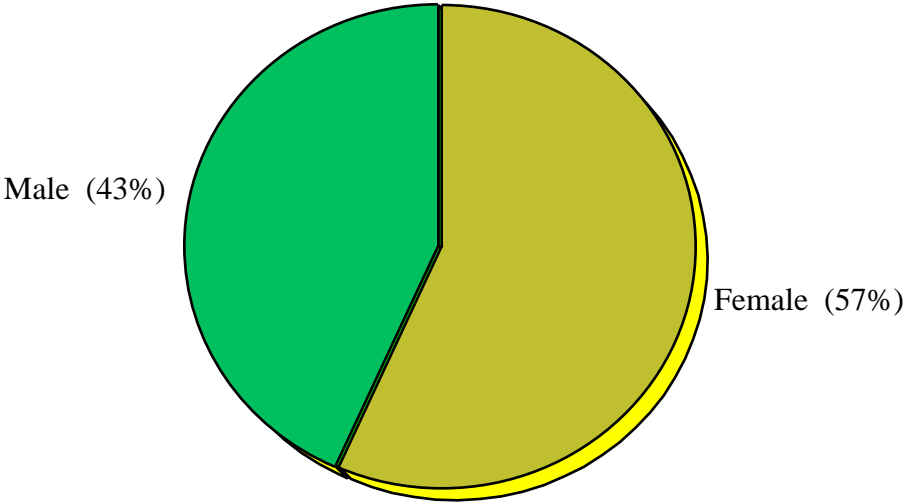

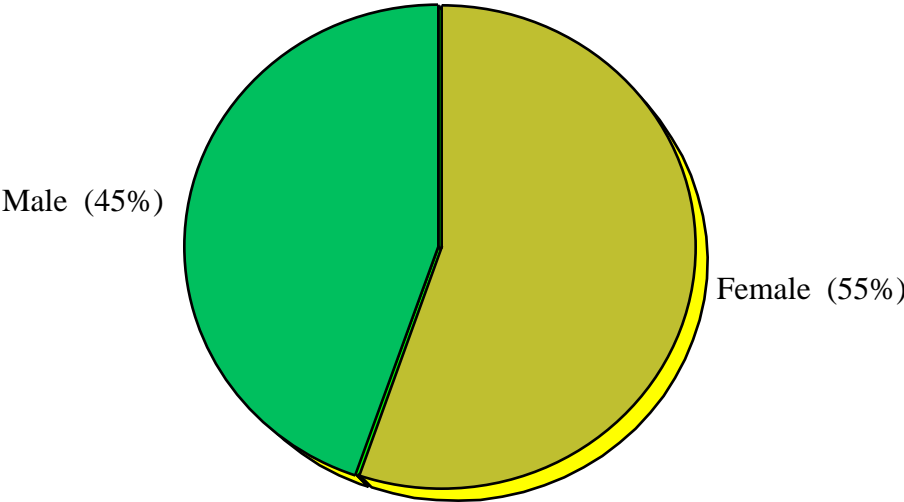

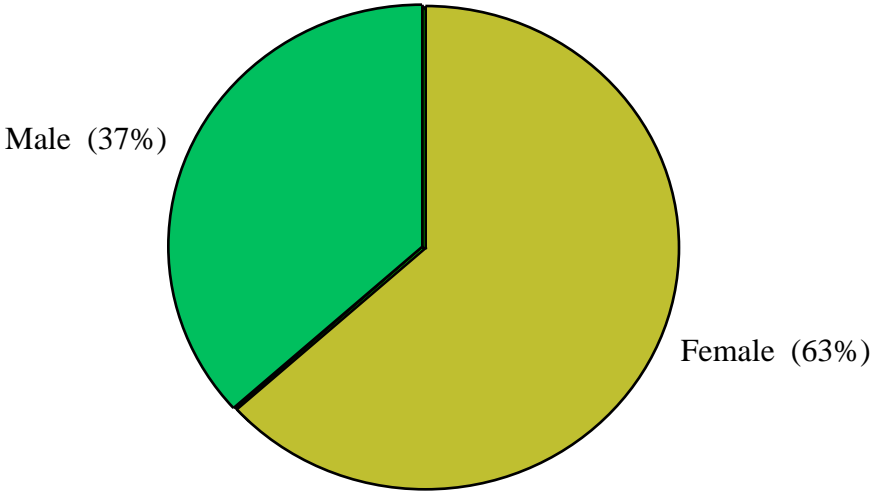
Fall 2000 Headcounts By Gender
