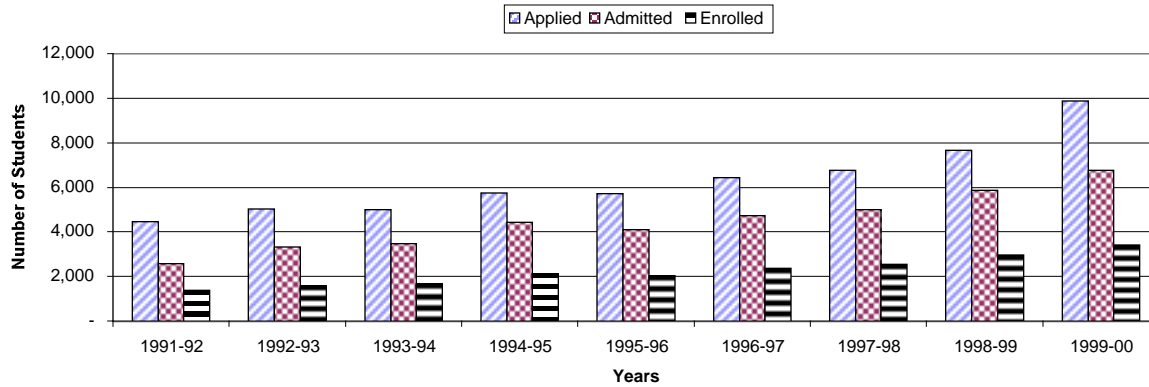

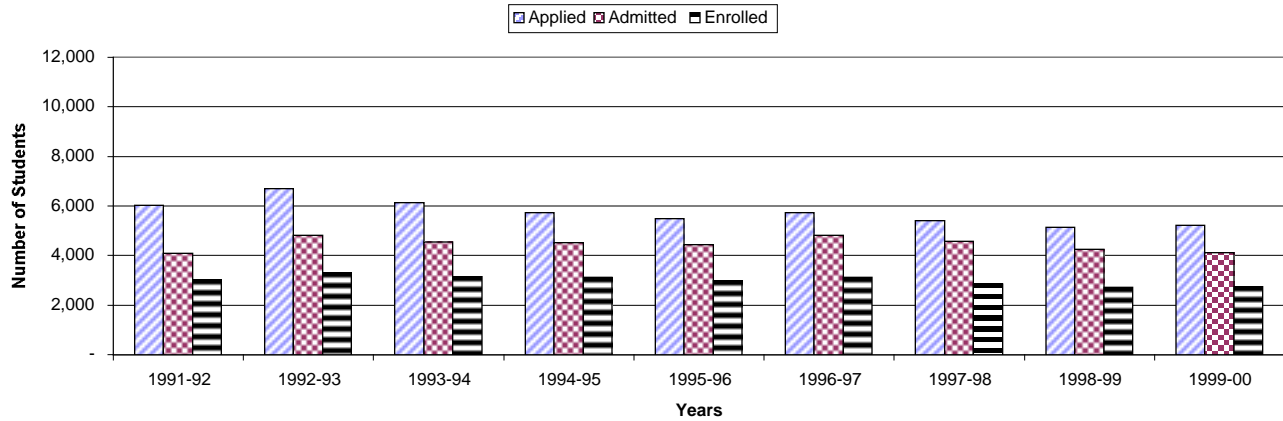

Whole Years: 1991/92 - 1999/00**



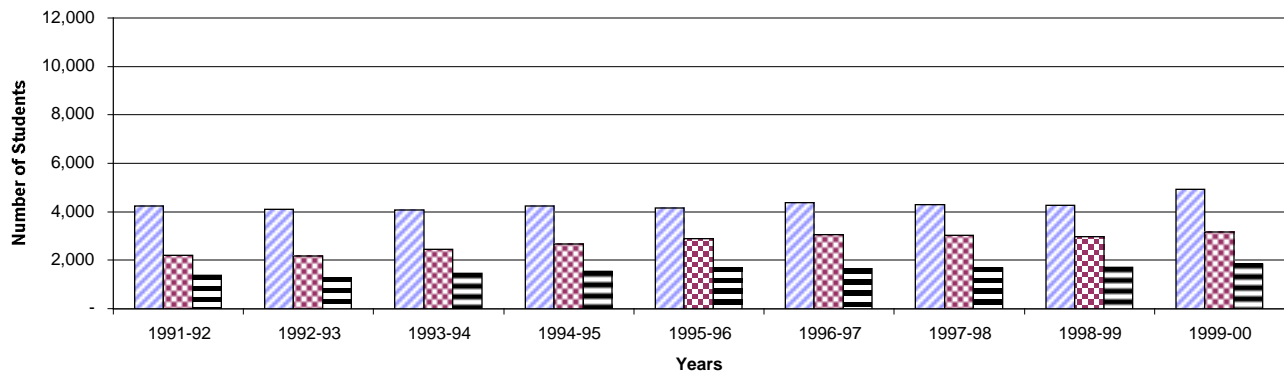

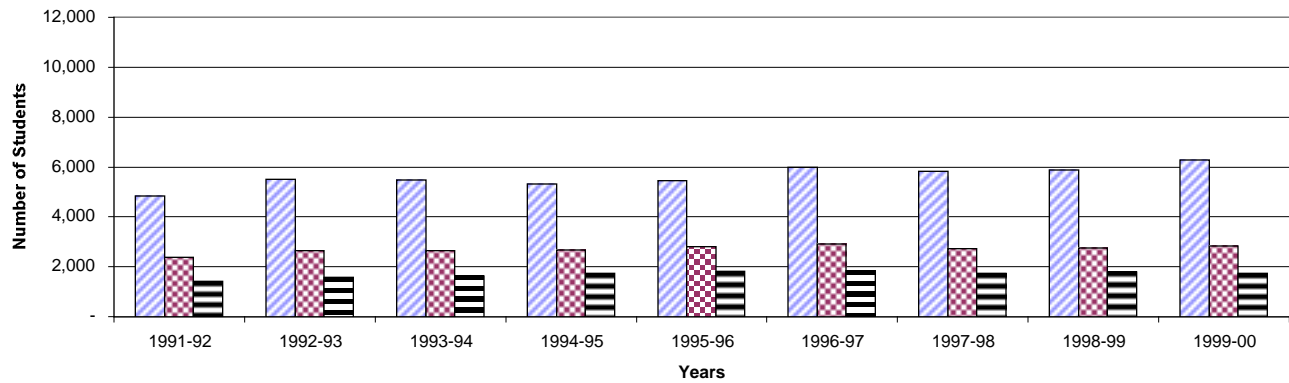

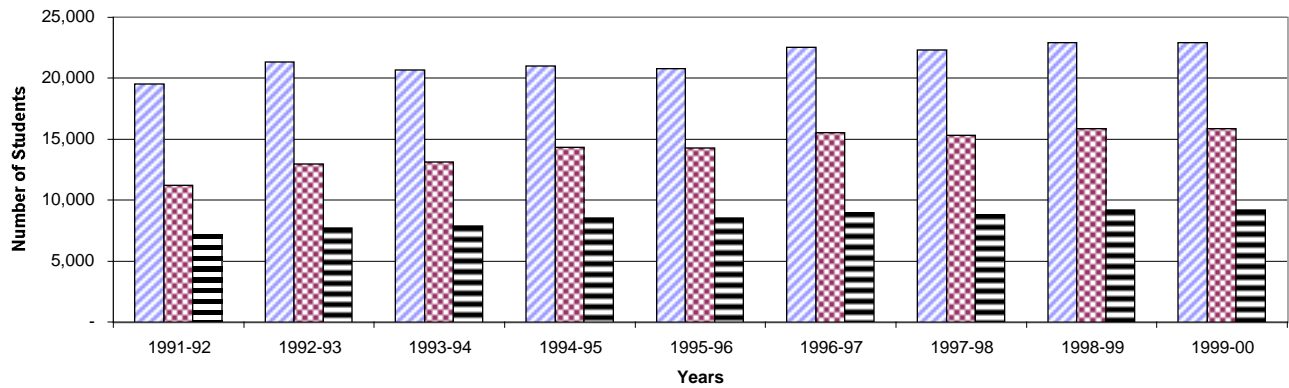
