

Basic census data categories

Social

Household/Family

Households; families; households with subfamilies; unmarried-partner households or families; same-sex partner households or families; mother-headed households or families with sub-adult children; ages of members (e.g.: 0-5, 6-14, 15-19, 20-24, 25-34, 35-44, 46-54, 55-64, 65-74, 75+); sex of members; race-ethnicity; principal language spoken at home; place of birth; national origin; citizenship; where lived five years ago.

Human Capital

Educational attainment; current school enrollment; current employment/unemployment; occupation; disabilities.

Geographic

Urban/rural

Economic

Income for previous full year; earnings for members 16+ years old; labor force status; employment status (employed full-time or part-time, unemployed), industry of employment; occupation; workplace.

Housing

Status/Type

Housing unit (e.g., single, multiple, mobile, boat, RV, van); group quarters; occupied and vacant units (and vacant-category); tenure; # of rooms and bedrooms; # units in structure.

Conditions & Attributes

Type of plumbing; kitchen facilities; year structure built; # occupants per room; # years of householder in unit; heating fuel; telephone service availability; vehicle availability; housing cost and financing; housing cost as % income; current market value; mortgage status; selected monthly owner costs; selected owner costs as % income.

Transportation

Place of work; usual means of transportation to/from work; # persons in the vehicle; time of departure to work; usual travel time to work; usual length of work trip; vehicles available.
